

Clinical Trial for Collagen VI-Related Myopathy

Who can join?

Children and Teens Ages 5 to 20 Years
Must have confirmed Collagen VI-related myopathy

Why are we doing this study?

This study is testing a new type of daily breathing treatment to see if it can change breathing function.

What is involved?

Half the participants will use a Cough Assist® machine to do breathing exercises twice a day and the other half of the participants will continue doing the same as they were before joining the research study.

Where is this Study being done?

This study is being done at Cincinnati Children's Hospital and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia.

The research study will pay for your travel.

How long does this study last?

This study lasts one year.

How many study visits are there?

You will travel to either Cincinnati or Philadelphia for 4 clinic visits.

The clinic visits will last about 4-6 hours.

The clinic visits include lung function tests and questionnaires.

There will be 6 phone visits with you while at home.
